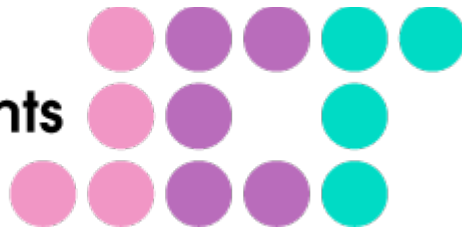

On 1 September 2022, I was appointed for a term of three years.

3/ What remuneration do they receive for this role?

I am authorised to work up to three days per month (36 days per year), but the work is demand led so I do not always work three days per month. My daily fee is £217.00.
